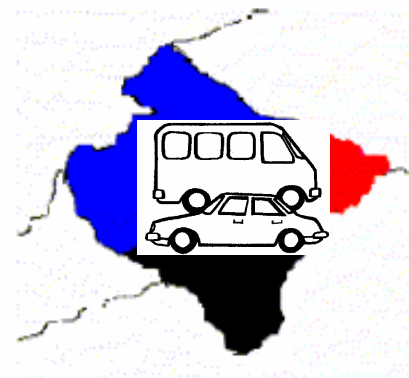


Devon's Health and Social Care Plan on Travel

There will be training so people can travel on buses and trains safely

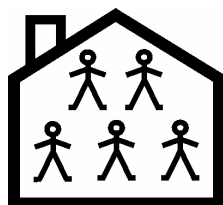


There will be work done with the bus companies to help them understand the needs of learning disabled people

We will be looking at other ways to help people with transport:



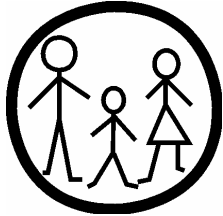
If a person lives in a residential home, supported living or adult placement, staff may be able to help with transport



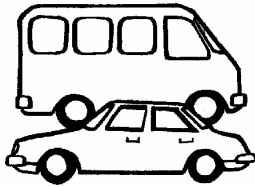
If a person has a car given to them by the Motability Scheme they may be able to use this for transport.

Some people with high support needs will always need special transport. We are looking at changing day centre buses.



There will be more people carriers instead



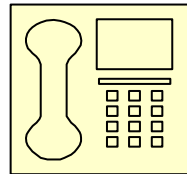
Any transport that people use which Health and Social Care pay for is to help people do more things in the community
