New Treetops Short Breaks is a very well appointed brand new purpose built unit in the Heavitree/Mount Pleasant district of Exeter.

It is situated at the end of quiet cul de sac within a residential area. The Nichols Fulfilling Lives Day Services are adjacent. The new Hydrotherapy Pool, next door, is now available for use by service users of the Shortbreaks Unit when appropriate. The unit is convenient to shops and a short walk/drive to the town centre.

New Treetops now provides a six bedded service, four of which have excellent facilities for individuals who may need to use a wheelchair. The service is available for men and women between the ages of 18 and 65 who have moderate to severe learning disabilities and who may also have a physical disability and/or sensory impairment. They are people who live with family carers within the Exeter district and currently a limited service is available to those in Mid Devon, Teignbridge and shortly the South Hams.

This short breaks service is designed to prevent or delay the need for permanent residential care or supported living by offering short periods of support to enable both service users and their regular carers to take a break from their normal routine.

We provide an exceptionally high quality service and take great care to ensure people are treated safely with dignity and respect.

Our experienced and skilled staff team are trained to meet the individual needs of those people who stay at New Treetops.
