We can help if it is difficult for you to understand things.



We can help you say what you want, or to make choices. This may mean using objects, symbols, photos or signing as well as talking.



We can help if you have eating and drinking difficulties.



We offer training to people who support you.

What to expect when a Speech and Language Therapist comes to see you



We will ring to arrange a time to come and meet you.

We may also ask people who support you for information.



Communication work:

On our first visit, we will talk to you and other people who help you.

We may need to see you a few times.



Eating and drinking:

We may need to come and watch you have your lunch and then offer advice to help you eat and drink safely.



At the end of our visits we will write a report. You will get a copy of this report with symbols and pictures if you find this easier to understand.




Communication referrals:
